

## St. Marian Scholarship Scheme

The selection criteria of all internal scholarships should be based on the guiding principle: ‘whole person development, learning with excellence’. Applicants could provide the following in their Personal Record as evidence for pursuing the aforesaid principle:

1. Mastery of fundamental knowledge of language, mathematics, science and technology or promotion of creativity in the cyber world as illustrated in e.g. mini inventions, mini masterpieces, mini research, mini ‘dissertations’ and project proposals which have been recognized in internal and external competitions;
2. Showing personal interests, inclinations, talents and potential in academic;
3. In possession of good taste in aesthetics with one or two types of personal interests, talents and potential in art, music, dance, speech and drama, etc.;
4. Demonstration of perseverance, seriousness of purpose, high motivation, spirit of discovery and community services;
5. Evidence of doing regular physical exercise with participation in at least one or two types of sports related activities;
6. Evidence of having good conduct, achieving above average academic results and maintaining satisfactory attendance record.
